Unexploded Ordnance

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an unidentified object, suspected of being an unexploded ordnance, has been found in position 50° 09.059'N 005° 02.798'W. See the chartlet below.

An exclusion zone of 300m, indicated by the red circle on the chartlet below has been enforced. All water users must keep well clear of the exclusion zone.

The object will be moved for disposal, time of moving is yet to be confirmed, but will be announced on VHF 16 by the Coastguard.

Port users should listen to VHF 16 for further updates from the Coastguard. A new Port Notice to Mariners will be published on 21.09.26 with any further updates.

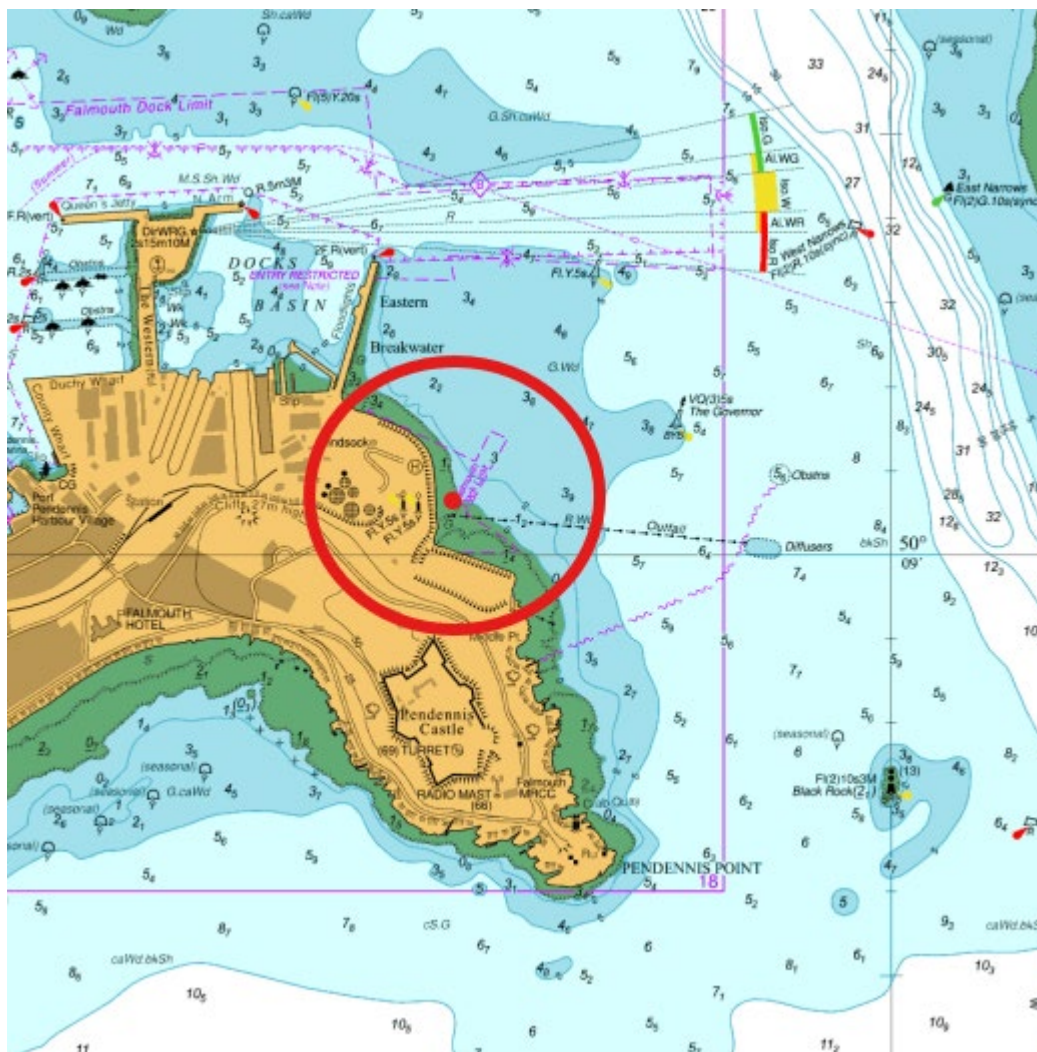
